Mahnomen Co. is a part of Economic Development Region 2, which is located in the Northwest Planning Region.


POPULATION CHARACTERISTICS



Mahnomen Co. is the 82nd largest of the 87 counties in the state. Its population decreased so far this decade, ranking as the 77th fastest growing in the state from 2020 to 2023. Mahnomen Co.'s population has a younger median age than the state and a larger percentage of people aged 65 years and older. The population is aging, especially as the Baby Boom generation moves through the population pyramid (see Figure 1).

Mahnomen Co. suffered a negative natural increase - more deaths than births from 2020 to 2023, but also experienced net out-migration - meaning more people moved out than moved in. Despite suffering domestic out-migration, Mahnomen Co. welcomed net international inmigration - gaining new Minnesotans from foreign countries (see Table 2).




Figure 2. Place of Birth for the Foreign Born Population, 2022

Mahnomen Co.'s population was becoming more racially diverse over time. Since 2011, the county's white population declined, but the number of people of other races increased (see Table 4).





POPULATION PROJECTIONS

According to the Minnesota State Demographic Center, Mahnomen Co.'s population is expected to decline from 2025 to 2035, with a rate of change that is slower than the projected statewide growth rate (4.5%). Despite the decline, the number of people aged 65 years and older is expected to decrease over the next decade (see Figure 4 and Table 5).

EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT


Mahnomen Co. has a lower percentage of adults (18 years & over) with at least a high school diploma than the state (93.0%), and a lower percentage of people with at least some college experience. Mahnomen Co. also has a higher percentage of people with an Associate's degree and a lower percentage of people with a Bachelor's degree or higher.



LABOR FORCE TRENDS

At 4.7%, Mahnomen Co. had a higher unemployment rate than the state in 2023. After the pandemic recession Mahnomen Co.'s unemployment rate declined compared to the 4.8% pre-pandemic rate posted in 2019. The number of unemployed workers actively seeking work in Mahnomen Co. increased over the past year, and is down compared to 2019.

Labor force growth has slowed in recent years. After experiencing a net gain of workers each year from 1990 to 2000, Mahnomen Co. averaged an annual gain of new workers from 2000 to 2010, and most recently a loss of fewer workers since 2010 (see Figure 7). Moving




The labor market had grown extremely tight in recent years, with less than 1 jobseeker per vacancy until the pandemic recession intervened in early 2020 and the number of unemployed workers spiked. In 2023, job vacancies in Northwest returned to pre-pandemic levels, but employers are still seeing challenges finding enough workers for open jobs (see Figure 8).



LABOR FORCE CHARACTERISTICS

Mahnomen Co. had a lower labor force participation rate than the state. The labor force in Mahnomen Co. is more racially diverse than the state (where 81.3% of workers are white alone), but is becoming more diverse over time.







INCOMES, COST OF LIVING, & HOUSING

Mahnomen Co. had a lower median household income than the state, and a higher percentage of households with incomes below \$50,000. Overall, Mahnomen Co. had the 87th highest median household income of the 87 counties in the state.



The cost of living has increased over the past 2 years with costs up in many areas. Mahnomen Co. had a lower cost of living than the state, with a required hourly wage of \$13.59 for a single person living alone to meet a basic needs cost of living, and an hourly wage requirement of \$18.05 for a typical family with 2 adults and 1 child (see Table 9).



Mahnomen Co. had a lower median house value than the state, having the 77th highest value of the 87 counties in 2022. Mahnomen Co.'s housing stock was older than the state's, with a lower percentage of units built since 2000 (see Figure 12).



OCCUPATIONS

At \$22.68 in 2024, wages were lower in Region 2 than the state. Overall, Region 2 had the 3rd lowest median hourly wage level of the 13 economic development regions in the state. Wages were highest for management occupations (\$44.66) and lowest for food preparation and serving related jobs (\$14.43) (see Table 11).



ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

Coming out of the pandemic recession, after gaining jobs over the past year, Mahnomen Co. had the 79th largest economy of the 87 counties in the state. Mahnomen Co. was the 1st fastest growing in the past year and the 61st fastest growing since 2019. From 2019 to 2023, employment in Mahnomen Co. is still down from the pandemic recession.

Figure 16. Industry Employment Statistics, 2008-2023


