PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

The Job Coaching for Sustainable Employment training is designed to implement qualified strategies and interventions which result in successful employment. Using best practices and a person-first delivery, this training will clarify and identify employer needs while addressing consumer skills and employment barriers. By establishing roles of the employment support team, this training will identify a coordinated plan of support to include specific job coaching tools and techniques, expectations of communication, and outcomes. The program was designed around the key objectives:

- *Onboarding: Identify employee barriers, accommodations, and goals. Identify Employer needs and expectations. Clarify team member roles, reports and documentation.*
- *Framework of Job Coach's role from initial visit to long term follow up support*
- *Professional Guidelines for Job Coaches regarding Rules of Conduct*
- *Advocacy and building natural supports both on site and external community supports*
- *Coaching techniques and tools: Job aids, skill building, and task analysis tools*
- *Sustaining Employment long term*
