# BEAD Challenge Timeline

*July 15th-July 21st:  
BEAD Challenge Portal opens, pre-registration begins*

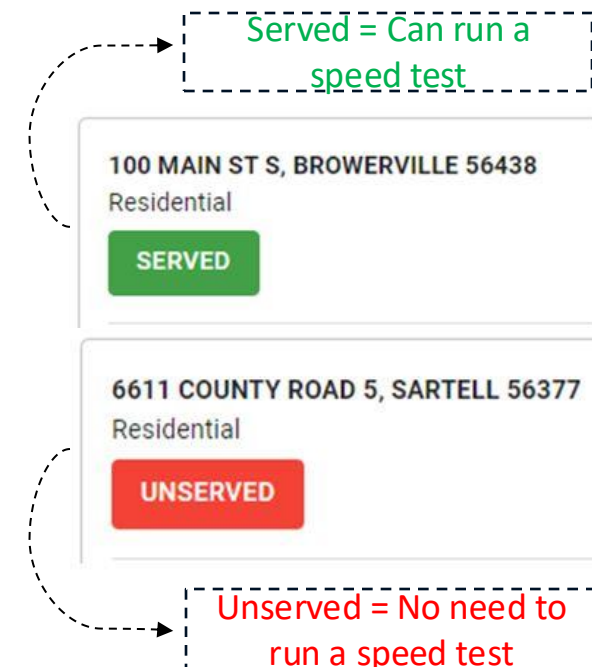


**July 22nd-August 21st**  
30-day BEAD Challenge Window

**August 22nd-September 20th**  
30-day BEAD Rebuttal window. *Rebuttal is due 30 days after notification.*

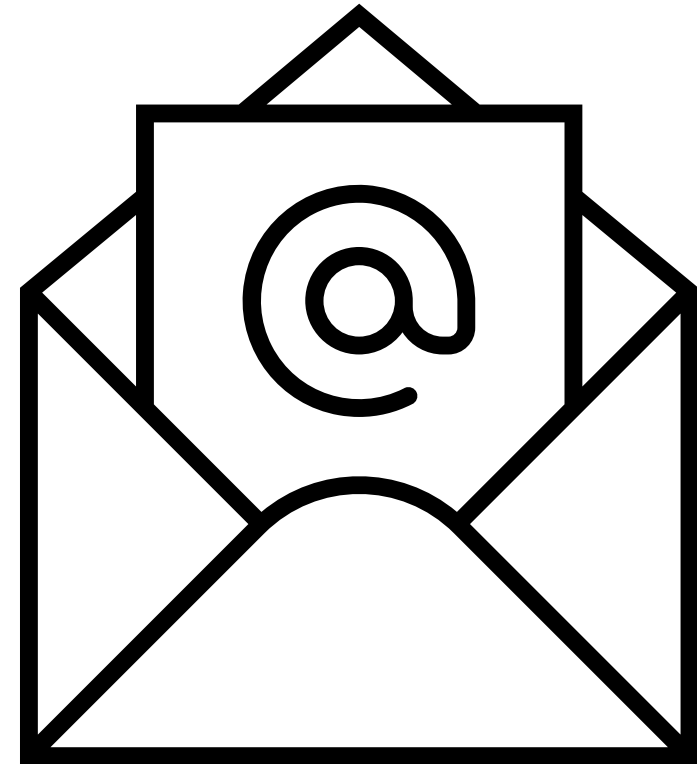
**September 21st-October 21st**  
30-day BEAD Adjudication by OBD

- The BEAD Challenge window closes **August 21** – don't wait until the last day in the event your Challenge is rejected as incomplete as you won't have any time to fix it
- **Reminder on speed tests.** Residents and businesses should only do speed tests in the BEAD Challenge Portal if their location shows as **SERVED** and they subscribe to service of at least 100Mbps download and 20Mbps upload and do not get those speeds when they do a speed test. The speed tests are then used to challenge your location as erroneously being listed as served. **If your location already shows as unserved, there is no reason to do a speed test as there is nothing to challenge.** Valid speed tests will then be submitted as BEAD Challenges by the non-profit Connected Nation. (Under NTIA requirements, only providers, non-profits, local and Tribal governments are eligible to submit BEAD Challenges.)

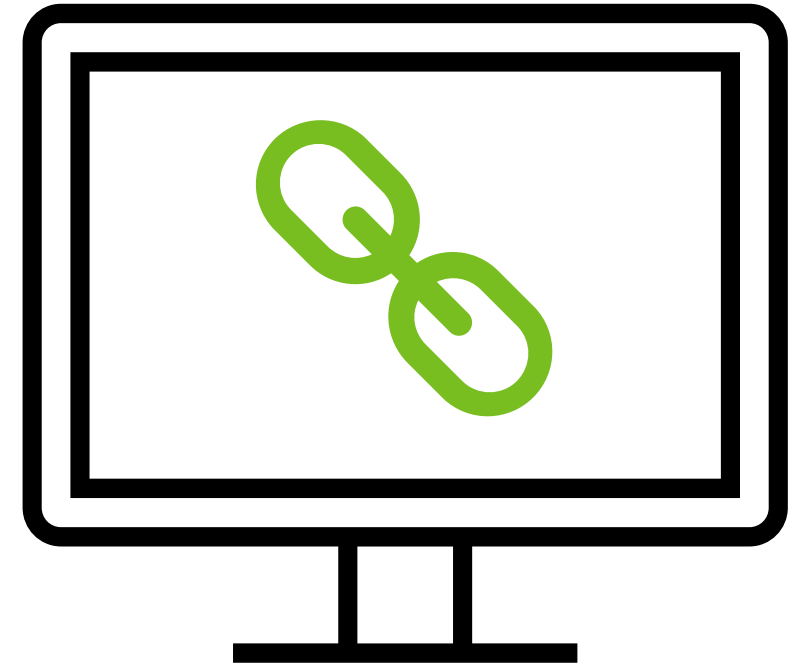
