Business Development Public Infrastructure Grant Program (BDPI)

\$9 million

BDPI funds public infrastructure improvements that promote future economic development. Grants target improvements to infrastructure such as wastewater collection and treatment, drinking water, storm sewer, utility extensions and roads. Funding is entirely targeted to Greater Minnesota communities and pays up to 50% of eligible public infrastructure costs.

Innovative Business Development Public Infrastructure Grant Program (IBDPI)

\$3 million

The IBDPI program supports job creation and retention through the growth of new innovative businesses. Eligible projects include those that target manufacturing, technology, warehousing and distribution, innovative business incubators, agricultural processing or industrial office or research park development that would be used by an innovative business. Funding is available statewide.

Transportation Economic Development Infrastructure Program (TEDI)

\$3 million

TEDI grants finance infrastructure to create economic development opportunities, jobs and improvements to all types of transportation systems statewide. Grants can support pre-design, land acquisition, construction, reconstruction and infrastructure improvements.

South Minneapolis CareerForce Location Asset Preservation

\$642,000

Phase III of this state bonding project will complete repairs, asset preservation and renovation to this CareerForce location which provides services to help people prepare for and find sustainable employment. This CareerForce location is heavily-trafficked and serves a diverse clientele.
