PROJECT BACKGROUND





- Broadband mapping started in 2008
- State Broadband Initiative (SBI) Program, 2010-2014
- Develop residential broadband coverage data at the most detailed level
- Aggregate and analyze broadband across the state
- Inform Border-to-Border grant eligible areas
- Conduct field validation to confirm service areas
- Collect public and provider feedback on service areas

PROVIDER OUTREACH AND DATA COLLECTION




- CN creates granular, statewide broadband map
- Residential broadband service
- Terrestrial, fixed broadband (DSL, cable, fiber, fixed wireless)
- CN contacts all providers for information
- Nondisclosure
 Agreements (NDA)
 executed as needed

- Maximum download and upload speeds for each area, each technology
- Wireless service: displayed as propagation models
- Wireline service: displayed as serviceable roads, service area footprints, route/drop maps


