





#### **Job Trends**






#### **Millennials**

Your area has 4,480 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,378.


















#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**









#### **Largest Occupations**





#### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**


Occupation Employment Concentration
