

Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis until funding is exhausted. All applications must be submitted in PDF format to AdultCompetitiveGrants.DEED@state.mn.us

Anticipated Notification to Applicants: Ongoing

Contract Start: Date all parties' sign

State Fiscal Year 2025 funds available: July 1, 2024

State Fiscal Year 2025 Contract End: December 31, 2025

Legislative and Administrative Considerations





Objective of RFP

The Department of Employment and Economic Development, through its Adult Career Pathways Programs is accepting applications from qualified responders to fund capacity building through the **Targeted Populations Capacity Building Grants.**

Program is outlined under:

Minnesota Statute 116L.43, Subd. 4

The Targeted Populations Capacity Building grants must result in the organizations increased capacity to provide quality workforce development services that are culturally and linguistically relevant to the community.



Legislative Considerations

As authorized in the Minnesota Session Laws - 2023, Regular Session, Chapter 53, Article 20, Sec.2 Subd. 3 (b3).

\$5,000,000 each year is for Capacity Building grants under Minnesota Statutes, section 116L.43, subdivision 4



Legislative Considerations

- Minnesota Statute section 116L.43
 - Defines the eligibility for organizations
 - Outlines the eligible activities
 - Provides requirements on other Targeted
 Populations grants
 - Workforce Programs
 - Diversity and Inclusion for Small Business

Maximum Award

 Applicants are limited to 1 application for a total of \$49,000



DEED Programming

The Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED) is committed to empowering the growth of the Minnesota economy for everyone.

The Targeted Populations Capacity Building Grants RFP is administered under DEED's Employment and Training Division Office of Adult Career Pathways.

All the Office of Adult Career Pathways RFPs support programs and services designed to improve economic opportunities for people of color, women, people with disabilities, and/or veterans in Minnesota.



Proposal Themes

Within DEED's Employment & Training Division, Adult Career Pathways programs focus on these three themes:

Innovation

Performance

Eligible Organizations

Eligible organizations must be community-based organizations. A community-based organization is defined as an organization that:

- Provides workforce development programming or services and;
- Is a nonprofit organization;
- Has an annual organizational budget of < \$1,000,000 and;
- Has primary office in a historically underserved community of color, or low-income community and;
- Serves a population that generally reflects the demographics of that local community.

All applicants must be currently operating, have an active non-profit designation, have an active business filing with the Minnesota Secretary of State in good standing, and have a physical business presence in the state of Minnesota at time of application.



Eligible uses of funds

- Workforce Program Delivery Staff-e.g.; navigator, supervisors, trainers
- Program Infrastructure-e.g.; Office equipment, supplies, accounting software
- Workforce Training Service Model Development-e.g; curriculum development, program development, outreach/marketing

All uses of funding must result in the increased capacity of the organization to provide quality workforce development services.

Strong Applications


When considering your application be sure to:

- Fill out the application completely
- Make sure that the application clearly outlines the plan for funds and that the plan is within eligible uses of funds.
- Include concrete objectives for your outcomes



Overview of Evaluation

Proposals will be evaluated and scored based on the following criteria. **Total points – 100 points**.



Post Selection Requirements





Tasks/Deliverables

- Submit quarterly narrative reports
- Submit monthly Reimbursement Payment Request Forms, with receipts
- Submit a final report outlining the use of funds and the impact of the funding on organizations ability to provide workforce development.



Post- Selection Requirements

Organizations awarded funds will need to:

- Provide Tax ID and Unique Entity Identifier Numbers
- Register as a Vendor in SWIFT
- And Additional State & Federal Requirements listed in the RFP
